

Janesville Area Crime Stoppers is a non-profit organization operated by a volunteer board of directors. Crime Stoppers encourages the reporting of information or leads that can assist law enforcement with solving crimes.

Funds raised by Crime Stoppers through the Race Against Crime and other events are used to pay rewards, provide grants to organizations to help keep the community safe and cover operating expenses.

Since 1985, Janesville Area Crime Stoppers have accounted for over 1300 arrests, recovered \$ 1,000,000 in stolen property, money and illegal narcotics. \$57,000 in rewards was paid to individuals providing information anonymously to solve those cases.

The Quick 50 program helps keep weapons and drugs out of the schools by offering a \$50 cash reward to students who provide information about weapons or drugs in school.

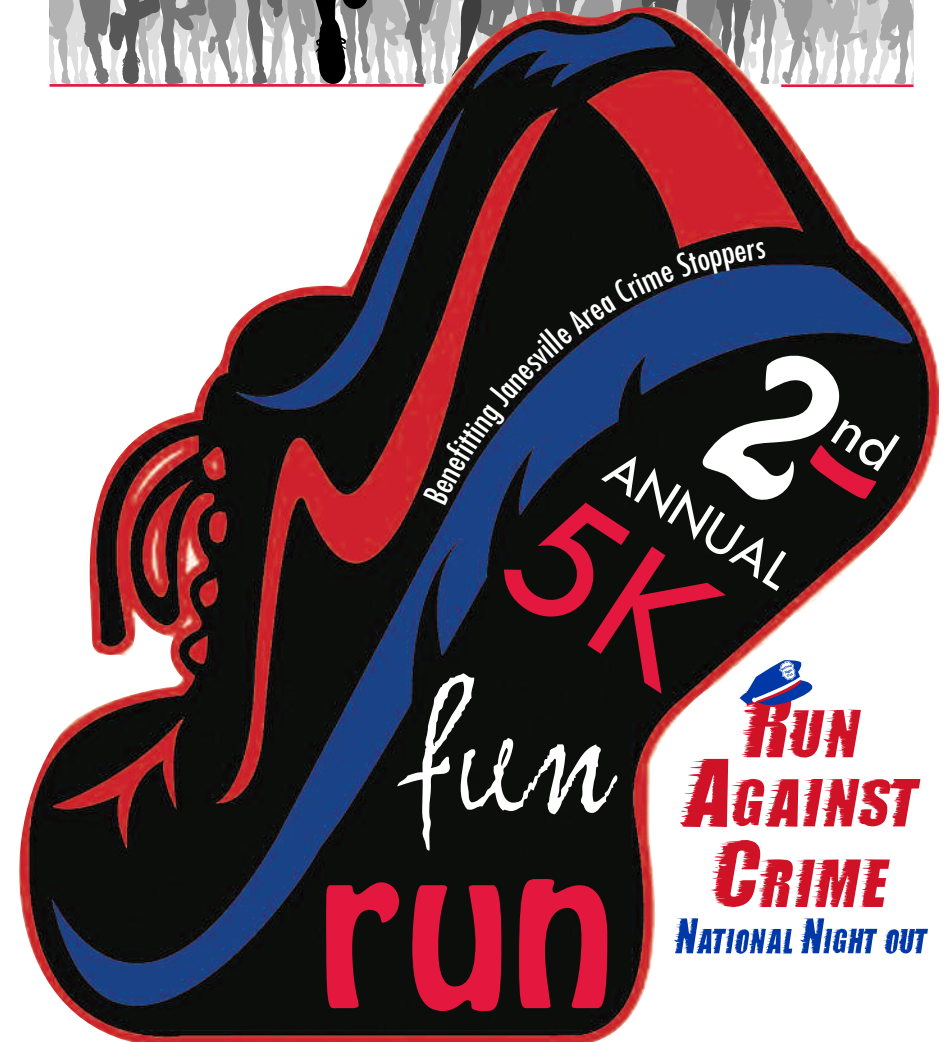
